Attempt *Question 2* and *Question 3*, selecting **one** of the two given options, in **each** question.

Question 1

- (i) Prepare a design for a scarf on the white cotton fabric (12" × 12") provided, using any two techniques of Tie and Dye, with a **single** colour. [2]
- (ii) Write the procedure of dyeing the sample. Mention the techniques used. [2]
- (iii) Tie and dye the given fabric following the procedure written by you. [5]
- (iv) **Iron and submit the finished sample to the Examiner.** [1]

Question 2

Attempt *any one* of the following:

(i) **Fibre identification:**

You are given **two** different textile fibres.

- (a) Mention **two** tests for identifying **each** fibre.
- (b) Write in detail the procedure you would follow to identify the two fibres.
- (c) Identify the **two** textile fibres, by making use of the procedure written by you. Write your observations and conclusions.
- (d) **Show the confirmatory tests and their results to the Examiner.**

OR

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(ii) **Laundering:**

- (a) Launder the synthetic dupatta following the appropriate procedure. Give finishing to the dupatta and leave it for drying. Iron and fold it.
- (b) **Show the laundered dupatta to the Examiner.**

Question 3

Attempt *any one* of the following:

- (i) Plan a pattern for a tea cozy. Print the planned pattern on the cloth, using leaves and vegetables.

Show the finished sample to the Examiner.

OR

(ii) **Repair work:**

- (a) Write the procedure for repairing a tear in the given cloth by darning, depending on the size of the tear.
- (b) Repair the given cloth by darning.
- (c) **Iron and show the repaired cloth to the Examiner.**
